**1. Collection and processing of data**

We collect and process personal data if you provide it to us by filling an entry form on our website or by other means, e.g. by e-mail. In addition, we collect and process data arising from your use of our website. Our data will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the Federal Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz – BDSG) and the German Telecommunication – Telemedia-Data Protection Act (Telekommunikation-Telemedien-Datenschutzgesetz (“TTDSG”)) as well as in accordance with relevant National and International laws, in reference to the policies of Heidelberg Materials. Personal data is all information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. In the following we explain in detail how we collect which data on which legal basis. In addition, we will explain to you what rights you have and how long your data will be stored.

**2. Processing of Data via Cookies and Logfiles**

Information on the use of cookies on our website can be found in our [cookie policy](#).

In accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sent. 1 b) and Art. 6 para. 1 sent. 1 f) GDPR, our website also uses so-called log files, in which access data are stored each time a page is accessed. The data record saved contains the following details:

- Your IP address, the date, the time, to which the file was accessed, the status, the request made by your browser to the server, the amount of data transmitted and the webpage from which you accessed the requested page (referrer) as well as
- The product and version information of the browser used, your operating system and your country of origin.

The log data are routinely deleted after 30 days. In other words, all data contained therein is irretrievably deleted. The usage of the log-files and its temporary storage is used to ensure a proper technical performance of the websites and to protect our websites against attacks and misuse. We do not use the log data for any other purposes.

### **3. External links**

Our website contains links to external websites. Social plugins such as the Facebook "Like" button are not used. The website protects your privacy by not directly integrating the external content into the website in these cases, but only by linking. Data can only be transmitted to the operator of the respective website when the link is activated. We are not responsible for the websites of other operators. In these cases, the data protection regulations of the other operator apply.

### **4. Third party providers**

#### **4.1 Cookie consent management**

Our website uses the cookie consent technology, to obtain your consent to the storage of certain cookies on your device and to document them in compliance with data protection regulations or to manage your cookie settings.

When you use our website, a connection is made to the provider's servers. We use the technology to obtain your consent and other declarations on the use of cookies. We then save a cookie in your browser in order to be able to assign you the consent given or the revocation thereof. The data collected in this way will be stored until you change your settings, remove the cookie or the purpose for data storage no longer applies. Mandatory statutory retention requirements remain unaffected.

#### **4.2 IDX™/Investis Digital**

We use the services of the provider IDX™/Investis Limited, Counting House, 53 Tooley Street, London, SE1 2QN for displaying share price information on our website. Legal Basis for processing of your personal data (IP address and geolocation) is Art. 6 para. 1 sent. 1 f) GDPR. Our legitimate interest is based on optimizing our online offer and our website.

### 4.3 Etracker

We use the services of etracker GmbH, Hamburg, Germany ([www.etracker.com](http://www.etracker.com)) to analyse usage data. In principle, no information from your device is read or stored for this analysis. Only the browser and header information is used for analysis purposes.

Legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 para 1 sent.1 f) GDPR. Our legitimate interest is the optimisation of our online offer and our website. You can object to the processing of your personal data by selecting the corresponding setting in our cookie banner or in your browser.

To the extent that we use analysis and optimisation cookies beyond that, we will obtain your explicit consent separately in advance via our cookie-banner. If you have consented, cookies are used to enable a statistical range analysis of this website, a measurement of the success of our online marketing measures and test procedures, e.g. to test and optimise different versions of our online offer or its components. Cookies are small text files that are stored by the Internet browser on the user's device. etracker cookies do not contain any information that could identify a user.

## 5. Processing of personal data by contacting us

overview of which data we are processing from you, i.e. the content of the respective form, any consent or other declarations of intent.

You can also assert the rights listed in Section 9 of this data protection declaration. Requests that we have answered or forwarded and for which there is no further legal basis for storage are automatically deleted from our systems after 2 (in words: two) months. Further information on the deletion of your data can also be found in section 10 of this data protection declaration.

## **6. Consent to receive our newsletter**

## Collection and Processing of Data

We collect and process personal data within the scope of the use of our social media presence by the data subjects. These data are processed in accordance with relevant National and International laws, in reference to the policies of Heidelberg Materials and also with the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) and the German Telemedia Act (TMG). "Personal data" are all information that refers to an identified or identifiable natural person. In the following, we explain in detail which data we collect and how and on what legal basis we do so. Moreover, we explain which rights you have and for how long your data are stored.

### Processing of Your Personal Data in the Context of Contacts

When you provide us with personal data by establishing contact, e.g. by e-mail or by means of a direct message in the social media, we process your data in accordance with relevant National and International laws, in reference to the policies of Heidelberg Materials and also data according to point (b) of Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 GDPR for the purpose of performing the contract or in order to take steps at your request prior to entering into a contract or pursuant to point (f) of Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 GDPR on the basis of our legitimate interest in answering your request. In this context, we process the data that you directly make available to us via your request. In the social media, these data comprise your username, your photograph and the message that you send us. Moreover, we may visit your public profile and save data from your profile if necessary for the above-mentioned purposes.

### Processing of User Data and Statistical Data

#### a) Processing of Personal Data

In all our social media presences, we receive notifications whether users of the social media "Like" our submissions, find them interesting, share, recommend or comment them, etc. (depending on the function of the social media). Furthermore, we can see a list of our followers or subscribers. On XING, we can see a list of the visitors to our social media presence on this platform. We can also see when you rate our company, insofar as the rating is linked to the respective social media presence.

#### b) Processing of Statistical Data

We also receive statistical analyses of the use of our social media presence from all social media providers. Apart from the information mentioned in 3. a), this merely comprises anonymised data, e.g. (depending on the provider) demographic data, an anonymised analysis of the interaction and reach of our social media presence and submissions, anonymised information such as language, interests and devices used by our users.

#### c) Processing of Data for Advertising Purposes, Creation of Usage Profiles by the Social Media Providers

The data specified under a) and b) can also be processed for market research and advertising purposes. For example, this takes place when we publish ads in the respective social media. However, the data are processed by the respective providers. Please also note that usage profiles may be created from your usage behaviour. In turn, these usage profiles can be used e.g. to publish ads in and outside the platforms that might suit your interests. More information on this is available from the respective social media providers.

#### d) Legal Basis for the Processing of Data

The processing of the data mentioned under a) to c) takes place pursuant to point (f) of Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 GDPR on the basis of our legitimate interests in target-oriented information of the users about us and our services as well as optimisation of our social media presence and effective communication with the users. If the respective social media providers ask the users for their consent to this processing of data (e.g. during registration by ticking a checkbox or by pressing a button), the legal basis of the processing is point (a) of Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 GDPR.

#### Categories of Recipients of Data, Other Controllers, Data Transfers to a Third Country

Service providers and agents engaged by us in connection with our social media presence, e.g. advertising agencies or IT service providers, may have access to the data mentioned in sections 2 and 3. Where these service providers and agents process data on our behalf, they are bound to instructions that we contractually impose on them.

By contrast, the social media providers are not bound to any instructions, but process your data on their own responsibility. Information about the providers and their contact details can be found on their websites. There you will also find information about the processing of your personal data. Please note, that your data may be processed by the social media providers outside the territory of the European Union. This could result in risks for you, e.g. because this could make it more difficult for you to enforce your rights. #### Your Rights

Pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR, you have the right to obtain, free of charge, information about the personal data stored concerning you. Pursuant to Art. 16, 17 and 18 GDPR, you also have the right to rectification of inaccurate data as well as restriction of processing and erasure of your personal data.

Under the conditions specified in Art. 20 GDPR, you also have the right to receive the stored data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from us.

Furthermore, pursuant to Art. 21 (1) GDPR, you have the right to object to the processing of personal data concerning you on the basis of point (e) or (f) of Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 GDPR, including profiling, on grounds relating to your particular situation. Where your personal data are processed for direct marketing processes, you have the right pursuant to Art. 21 (2) GDPR to object at any time to the processing of your data for such marketing, including profiling to the extent that it is related to such direct marketing.

We will fulfil your aforesaid rights insofar as the statutory requirements for asserting the rights are on hand.

Please submit all requests concerning your personal data to the respective social media provider or to the contact details specified at the beginning of this Privacy Policy.

Moreover, every data subject has the right to lodge a complaint concerning our processing of data with a data protection supervisory authority.

#### Duration of the Storage and Routine Erasure

Unless specified otherwise for the specific data processing in this Privacy Policy, we only process and store personal data for the period required for the achievement of the purpose of the processing or to the extent provided for in laws or regulations that we are subject to.

If the purpose of the storage no longer applies or a storage period required by law ends, the personal data will be routinely blocked or erased according to the statutory regulations.

We may also store the data and information specified in sections 2 and 3 outside the social media. However, the aforesaid applies to the duration of the storage.
